Anointing vs Power?

- **Anointing** – consecrated, appointed to do
- **Power** – The Holy Spirit giving you His ability to do: naturally, spiritually, grace, wisdom, know how, etc. (may be in seed form and needs to grow)
- **Authority** – given to you by God the Father, through Jesus Christ our Lord

- There is **ALWAYS** a **reason** why the anointing and power of God rest upon your life.
- There is always a **purpose** *WHY* His anointing manifest in your life the way it does

There is always a purpose why the Lord created you the way He did, all this this is connected to the WHY of you – the PURPOSE of why the gifts of healing flow through you the way it does.

What does the gifts of healing have to do with spiritual warfare?



- It is the removal of one kingdom and the establishing of another Kingdom
- It is the forceful removal of the kingdom of darkness, and the active dominance of the kingdom of Heaven
- Removal of
 - systems of darkness that has been set up,
 - Tearing down of strongholds
 - Changing mindsets, beliefs
 - Territorial rights

- There are only 2 Kingdoms:
 - Kingdom of Heaven, Matthew 13 & Col. 1:13
 - Kingdom of darkness – Luke 11:18
- Each kingdom has territory – and the battle is to gain ground, to gain as much territory as possible – this is how we advance the Kingdom

- When we exercise the gifts of healing, we are legislating (enacting the law of God!!) in the earth and in that person's life.
- The Gifts of Healing establishes the kingdom of heaven in that person's life, that territory becomes the territory of our Lord and Savior.
